Under the overarching theme “**New solutions to complex challenges – A public sector citizen-centric, sustainable and fit for the future**”, EPSA 2019 seeks to showcase and reward those cases submitted by public administrations

which have found new solutions in public service delivery and policy-making for the increasingly difficult to address and often multi-dimensional challenges faced by the public sector everywhere in Europe.

This theme is broad and inclusive to make it easier for all public sector institutions irrespective of their function or size to enter if they have new solutions to today's complex challenges, such as demographic change, climate change, technological transformation, security and the maintenance of social security.

Who can apply to EPSA 2019?

The award scheme is open to **European public sector institutions from all administrative levels**, as well as public sector enterprises, agencies and public-private partnerships. The lead applicant must be a public sector institution or authority - other applicants in a consortium, can for example be private companies, semi-public institutions, NGOs, universities or training institutions.
