The MELS Online is a unique and prestigious master's degree programme that provides in-depth knowledge of European law and governance, with a focus on the practical application of EU law in the context of national legal systems. The program is taught by a team of leading academics and practitioners in the field of EU law, and is designed to prepare students for a successful career in the EU institutions, national administrations, law firms, NGOs, and other relevant sectors.
